# A future for the International Bureau for Epilepsy

### **Introduction and background**

- IBE was established in 1961. It is the recognised international umbrella body representing national epilepsy organisations that have a specific interest in improving the social condition and quality of life of people with epilepsy and their carers.
- Since its establishment, IBE has grown and is continuing to grow, measured by the number of its members, with 120 Full and Associate Members in 92 countries.

There is no other similar credible organisation with the same broad Goals and Objectives or the same constituency of stakeholders as IBE.

- Epilepsy and those affected by the condition are experiencing a process of dynamic change reflected by changes in world-wide economic, technological, medical, political and social circumstances.
- The current and forecast future demand on IBE's resources outweighs the organisation's ability to satisfy the demands and expectations being placed upon it.
- This document presents a strategic response to this situation. It offers a way forward to ensure that IBE has a practical, relevant and meaningful future.
- Once agreed, it will be the International Executive Committee's task to ensure the strategy is delivered through action plans and outcomes that should be reported back to the Members and other stakeholders.
- This document is an updated version of the previous Strategic Plan that was in place from 2005-2009.

### **Strategy**

Vision –IBE has a vision of the world where everywhere ignorance and fear about epilepsy are replaced by understanding and care.

Mission – IBE exists to improve the social condition and quality of life of people with epilepsy and those who care for them.

Goals – To achieve its vision and mission, IBE has set the following Goals:

#### 1. Organisation

To provide an international umbrella organisation for national epilepsy organisations (Members of IBE) whose primary purpose is to improve the social condition and quality of life of people with epilepsy and those who care for them.

### 2. Support

To provide a strong global network to support the development of new Members, to support existing Members to develop to their fullest potential and to encourage co-operation and contact between Members.

#### 3. Communication

To promote the facts about epilepsy and to communicate IBE's vision, mission and messages to the widest possible audience.

#### 4. Education

To increase understanding and knowledge of epilepsy.

#### 5. Representation

To provide an international and global platform for the representation of epilepsy.
