





 - anticipates and complements the activities of the EU Framework
 Programmes
 - increases the mobility of researchers across Europe.

- COST actions 'bottom-up' approaches to research and will facilitate, networking and other events.
 - There are no funds for research as such but reimbursement for expenses in conjunction with flights and accommodation to COST meetings
 - leads to excellent contacts and can also lead to preparation for future grant proposals eg as in FP




