## 28th International Epilepsy Congress in Budapest.

Preliminary work to organize the 7<sup>th</sup> Latin American Congress of Epilepsy to be held in November 2012 in Quito, Ecuador;

Research Task Force with the inclusion of Tomás Mesa, is gathering information about epilepsy research in different regions of the world. A survey with this intent was sent by email;

Chile is conducting the Project TRAINING SCHOLARS OF BASIC EDUCATION ON EPILEPSY, using the video "Juanito" in different Latin American countries;

With a grant from the Chilean League against Epilepsy in association with the Chilean Society of Psychiatry and Neurology of Infancy and Childhood, a manual CONSENSUS IN THE MANAGEMENT OF ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUGS IN SOME ELECTROCLINICAL SÍNDROMES AND OTHER EPILEPSIES IN CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS was published to be distributed during the congress in Rome;

Approval in WHO of the STRATEGIC AND ACTION PLAN ON EPILEPSY FOR THE AMERICAS, elaborated by Dr. Carlos Acevedo and Dr. Marco Tulio Medina;

Posters about the work of each member of LA IBE will be displayed during next congress in Rome;
